A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia annually recognizes the importance of protecting and conserving our rich and diverse heritage by proclaiming Heritage Week, and

WHEREAS Heritage Week annually commences on national Heritage Day, the third Monday in February, and

WHEREAS the theme for Heritage Week 2010 is Heritage of Sport and Recreation, and

WHEREAS British Columbia celebrates the heritage of sport and recreation, and

WHEREAS our communities are defined by all their buildings, sites, and historic places, and

WHEREAS British Columbia acknowledges that people from all walks of life and from every community contribute to our rich cultural heritage, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002,

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents acknowledge the history of sport heritage in Canada and in this Province, and proclaim and declare that the week of February 15 to 21, 2010, shall be known as

**“Heritage Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
